



Stratifying Patient Immune Endotypes in Sepsis

Healthy Control

This is a multicenter, observational clinical study of critically ill patients with or without sepsis. The purpose of this research study is to learn more about the immune function of patients who are critically ill and may or may not have sepsis by collecting blood samples at the time of their illness.

As a healthy control you will be asked to donate blood to serve as a reference control to help our team better understand the immune system suppression during critical illness.

Eligibility

- Adults 45 and up
- Ability to obtain Informed Consent prior to blood collection.
